As Geographers, we will be studying our local area. We will be learning about the weather in Bournemouth through the year, understanding and drawing maps.

As Artists, we are studying different ways of creating sculptures. We will be exploring how to manipulate clay before creating our own clay sculpture.



As Scientists, we are observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will then find out that plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

As writers, we will be retelling the story 'the Little Boat', writing postcards based on our book 'At the beach' and writing Non-fiction texts including instructions.

We are hoping to explore our local area during this topic with a trip to the beach.
