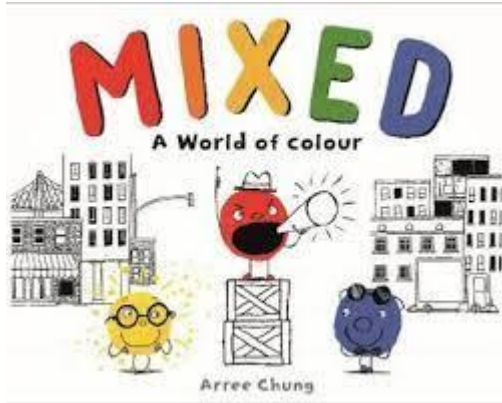
Year 1 - Local study

Enquiry Questions

What different kinds of plants are there?

What maps do we use?

How can we look after our local area?



Key Vocabulary:

Plant, flower, leaf, petal, stalk, evergreen, deciduous, compass, weather, north, south, east, west, map, pattern, print

The National Curriculum

This topic will focus on Geography and Science. The children will learn about the local area we live in, the weather in Bournemouth and the most common plants that grow here. They will learn about the parts of plants and about different types of trees. In Geography, we will look at aerial maps and learn how to look after our local area. We will do a nature walk and litter pick to Winton Rec.

As mathematicians, the children are looking at multiplication as adding groups and division as sharing. They will learn about position and direction and consolidate their place value knowledge with numbers up to 100.

As writers, the children will be retelling stories, writing instructions and exploring poetry.

As artists, the children will look at the work of Romero Britto and explore printing with different materials.

As musicians, the children will be learning about tempo and dynamics and how music makes the world a better place.
