

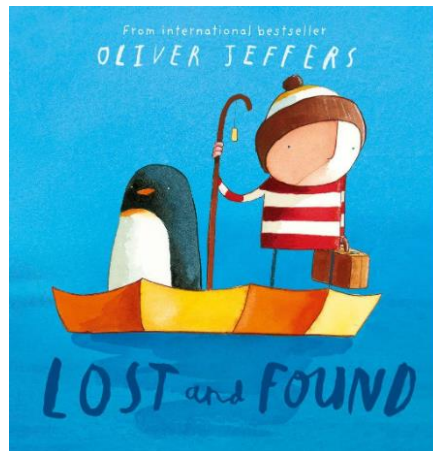


## Enquiry Questions

What are the capital cities of the UK countries?

What is your favourite season and why?

Why is Easter important to Christians?



### Key Vocabulary:

England, Ireland, Scotland, Wales, United Kingdom, plan, evaluate, tempo, suffix, calligram, salvation, glockenspiel, clave

This topic will be Geography led and the children will learn about the countries in the United Kingdom and their capital cities. They will compare the similarities and differences between them and will learn about their seas, mountains and rivers.

As Writers, the children will be writing calligram poems. They will develop their story writing skills and learn about suffixes as well as continuing to work on using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. As mathematicians, the children will be consolidating place value up to 50. They will continue using concrete resources, such as numicon, dienes and bead strings to support them with their learning. Later, they will move on to learn about length, height, mass and volume.

As designers, the children will be investigating pizzas and will plan, make and evaluate their own.

As musicians, the children will be learning about tempo and will be introduced to the glockenspiel and claves. They will practice and perform a song to parents towards the end of term.
